Come to the pub for a match, and you might just end up bringing home a cool framed picture of The Normal One.



Raleigh Members go to Anfield

One of the key benefits to membership of OLSC Raleigh is the ability to procure tickets to upcoming matches during the season.

How does it work? It's quite simple, as long as you can start planning well in advance. For ticket allocation, the club splits the season into two halves, before and after January 1. Once the schedule is released in the summer, the club immediately starts accepting ticket requests from OLSC branches for matches before January 1. There typically isn't much time to get the requests in, so you need to be on the ball. If our request is granted, you are not financially obligated to purchase the tickets until about six weeks prior to the match. If you think that you will be in England and want to catch a match, there is nothing to lose by requesting tickets. If you can't make it for some reason, there is no penalty and the tickets will be reassigned. Ticket allocation for matches after January 1 usually occurs in mid-October.



Back in April, a group of six Raleigh Reds traveled across the pond to watch the 2-2 match against Bournemouth. Our seats were fantastic right behind the Anfield Road end goal which Philippe Coutinho scored a great goal.



Earlier this season, Steve Quasny was able to get three tickets to the home opener against Crystal Palace for his family to enjoy. In November, Colin Anderson brought his father to Anfield for the first time ever as they watched the Reds dismantle Southampton 3-0. Later this season we have other members going to see the Stoke City and Brighton matches respectively.
